And it is not just the words people say...

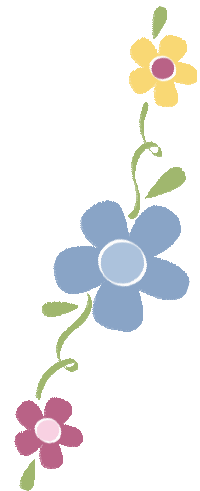
A cheerful greeting received in the mail
